[Introduction]

[Main]

1. Time schedule that will absolutely be fulfilled

- 1) Christ who will come – what happened to those who grabbed hold of the covenant of the coming Christ?
 - (1) Moses (Genesis 3:15, 6:14, 12:1-3, Exodus 3:18)
 - miracle of exodus from Egypt
 - (2) Isaiah (Isaiah 7:14) → miracle of exodus from Babylon
 - (3) Early church (Matthew 16:16) → miracle of exodus from Rome
- 2) Christ, who came – what happened to those who met Christ, who came?
 - (1) Acts 1:1 (doctor Luke) – witness of Christ
 - (2) Acts 1:3 – coming of the kingdom of God
 - (3) Acts 1:8 (power) – power that God granted from above was revealed wherever they went
 - (4) Acts 1:14 – gathering of people who had no reasons because they knew the reasons
 - (5) Acts 2:1 – filling of the Holy Spirit, answer of answers
 - (6) Acts 3:1-10 – “in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk” (6)
 - (7) Acts 4:12 – “Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”

(8) Romans 16:25-27 – we can enjoy what has been present since long ages past and will be to eternity.

3) Time schedule that the lost Gospel is restored

- (1) 7 Remnants of the Bible – Joseph (4 generations), Moses (400 years), Samuel and David (14 judges), Elijah and Elisha, Isaiah, the early church (700 years)
- (2) Luther (1500 years)
- (3) 500 years after since Religious Reformation – who will restore the Gospel now?

2. Time schedule that God will carry out

- 1) Mount of Calvary, Mount of Olives, Mark’s upper room (Acts 1:1, 3, 8)
- 2) Antioch church (Acts 11:19-30)
- 3) Macedonia (Acts 16:6-10)
- 4) Rome (Acts 19:21, 23:11, 27:24)

3. Time schedule that will change the world

- 1) Jesus’ public life – trained for what will take place after 3 years
- 2) Antioch church – answer was granted to prepare for the ages of 70 A.D. (fall of Jerusalem), 79 A.D. (Pompeii volcanic eruption), and 313 A.D. (religious toleration for Christianity)
