[Main]

1. Jesus' communication with people

- 1) Matthew 5:1-7:29 (Sermon on the Mount) – three wrong things
 - (1) True blessing (Matthew 5:3-12) – poor in spirit (heaven), mourn (comfort), meek (inherit the earth), hunger and thirst for righteousness (filled), merciful (shown mercy), pure in heart (see God), peacemakers (children of God), persecuted because of righteousness (heaven), insulted because of the Lord (great reward in heaven)
 - (2) True prayer (Matthew 6:33) – seek first his kingdom and his righteousness
 - (3) True walk of faith (Matthew 7:5) – take the plank out of your own eye
- 2) John 6:1-71 (crowd and disciples) – “The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing” (63)
- 3) Matthew 8:1-17 (physical healing and spiritual healing) – purpose of physical healing is for life and disciples (17)

2. Jesus' communication with disciples – Matthew 16:13-20

- 1) Selection – focus on select few (Mark 3:13, Matthew 4:19)

“called to him those he wanted, and they came to him” (Mark 3:13)
- 2) Living together – with (Mark 3:14, “be with him”)
- 3) Example – model (1 Corinthians 11:1, Philippians 4:9)

“as I follow the example of Christ” (1 Corinthians 11:1)

- 4) Obedience – cross (Luke 9:23-24, Philippians 2:5-8, Galatians 2:20)

“And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death – even death on a cross!” (Philippians 2:8)
- 5) Commission – delegation (Matthew 10:1-42)

“And if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones who is my disciple, truly I tell you, that person will certainly not lose their reward.” (42)
- 6) Allocation – the Holy Spirit (John 14:26-27, 16:13-27)

“But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.”
- 7) Examination – continuation (forum, Luke 10:17-20)

“However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”
- 8) Reproduction – disciple (Matthew 28:16-20)

3. Jesus' communication with the world

- 1) Matthew 28:16-20 – go to all people
- 2) Mark 16:15-20 – go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.
- 3) Acts 1:8 – you will be my witnesses to the ends of the earth
