[Introduction] You must have personal time of concentration.

1. Personal time of concentration in the Bible – mountain, river, wilderness, forty day, ten days, three Sabbath days, three months, two years
2. Three healings through personal time of concentration – physical (breathing), minds and thoughts (brain), spiritual healing (Word)

The method of methods is Word imprint → Genesis 1:1-13, Isaiah 40:6-8, Hebrews 4:12, John 1:1-14, Revelations 1:3

[Main]

1. Word forum for remnants who are in elementary school and under → audiovisual aids + Word

- 1) What did seven Remnants from the Bible do? – forum regarding the Word and works that actually took place
- 2) It must be presented how the working of the Triune God has elapsed.
- 3) Acts 1:1, 3, 8 – why does it have to be Christ (↔working of Satan), kingdom of God (↔kingdom of darkness), and filling of the Holy Spirit (↔working of evil spirits)?
- 4) Accurately teach them what worship is (John 4:23-24).
- 5) What is only, uniqueness, and recreation?

It must be found and presented only, uniqueness, recreation of seven Remnants of the Bible that were demonstrated in the Word.

2. Word forum for middle school, high school, college, young adults → field + Word

- 1) Genesis 39:1-6 – field that Joseph saw
- 2) 1 Samuel 3:1-18 – field that Samuel saw
- 3) Psalm 78:70-72 – field that David saw
- 4) 2 Kings 2:1-11 – field that Elisha saw
- 5) Isaiah 6:1-12, 13 – field that Isaiah saw
- 6) Acts 1:6-7, 8 – field that the early church saw
- 7) 2 Timothy 3:1-13, 14-17 – field that Timothy saw

3. Word forum for older adults → future + Word

- 1) Acts 1:1, 3, 8, 14 – must conclude firmly holding onto the covenant
- 2) Acts 2:1-13 – fulfillment and working of the covenant that took place in Mark's upper room
- 3) Acts 13:1-4 – guidance of the Holy Spirit for covenant conveyance
- 4) Acts 16:6-10 – covenant that was relayed to Macedonia
- 5) Acts 19:1-7 – Tyrannus movement and door to Rome evangelization
