[Introduction]

Satan's goal is destruction of mankind; God's goal is redemption of mankind (John 10:10, 1 Peter 1:9)

[Main]

1. Rightfulness

- 1) Existence of mankind – spiritual being that rightfully have to meet God (Genesis 1:27-27)
- 2) Rightful problem and rightful answer
 - (1) Rightful problem (12 problems) – fundamental problems, long-standing problems, personal destruction state – Matthew 24:1-25:41, 2 Timothy 3:1-13, Revelation 12:1-9
 - (2) Rightful solution – only Christ
- 3) People who discovered rightfulness – 7 Remnants of the Bible, witnesses of faith of Babylon, early church (Romans 16)

2. Inevitability

- 1) Inevitable problem and inevitable answer
 - (1) Inevitable problem – Egypt (Pyramid), Philistia (temple of Dagon), Aram (temple of Rimmon), Assyria (Baal, Asherah), Babylon (Nebo statue), Rome (temple of Zeus) → result was destruction

- (2) Inevitable answer – Egypt (Joseph, Moses), Philistia (Samuel, David), Aram (Elijah, Elisha), Assyria (Hezekiah), Babylon (Isaiah, Daniel), Rome (Paul, Timothy)

2) What God requires

- (1) Gospel – Genesis 3:15, 6:14, 12:1-3, Exodus 3:18, Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 16:16
- (2) Church – Mark's upper room (Acts 2:1-47), Antioch (Acts 11:19-30), Rome (Romans 16:1-27)
- (3) Evangelist – Matthew 16:13-20, 28:16-20, John 21:15-18, Acts 1:1-14, Romans 16:1-27

3. Absoluteness

- 1) Absolute problem and absolute answer
 - (1) Absolute problem – Satan, curse and disaster, background of hell
 - (2) Absolute answer – Acts 1:1, 3, 8
- 2) God's 3 absolute ministries – Word fulfillment, prayer answer, redemption works
- 3) Absolute devotion that God wants
 - Gospel restoration (Acts 1:1) + enjoyment (Acts 1:3) + conveyance (Acts 1:8)
