[Introduction]

[Main]

1. One heart – Gospel imprint

- 1) Meaning – one heart is a life of those who discovered and saw Christ (Philippians 3:1-21)
- 2) Content and method of one heart – John 19:30, Acts 1:1, 14, 2:1, 42
- 3) Witness of one heart – witnesses of exodus from Egypt (Exodus 3:18), exodus from Babylon (Isaiah 7:14), exodus from Rome (Matthew 16:16)
- 4) Answer of one heart – healing of fields, healing of church, healing of individual

2. Whole heart – Word root

- 1) Meaning – life of those who found value of staking one's life and staked one's life (1 Samuel 17:29, Acts 20:24)
- 2) Content and method of whole heart – Acts 2:1-13, 41-42, 43-45
- 3) Witness of whole heart
 - (1) One who found reasons to stake one's life – answer of 12 life problems
 - (2) One who knows content to save – Gospel (Acts 1:1, 3, 8)
 - (3) One who recognizes a method that God desires – Gospel recovery + enjoyment + conveyance

- 4) Answer of whole heart – transformation in fields, transformation of church, transformation in the age (idolatrous culture → Gospel culture)

3. Continuation – evangelism nature

- 1) Meaning – one's life in order to bind forces of darkness and to seek out and prepare for blessings of one who will remain to save future
- 2) Content and method of continuation – Acts 2:46-47, 3:1, 4:12, 5:42, 11:19-30, Romans 16
- 3) Answer of continuation – prevented Satan, disaster, war culture (resolved the age of salve, captive, colonization)
