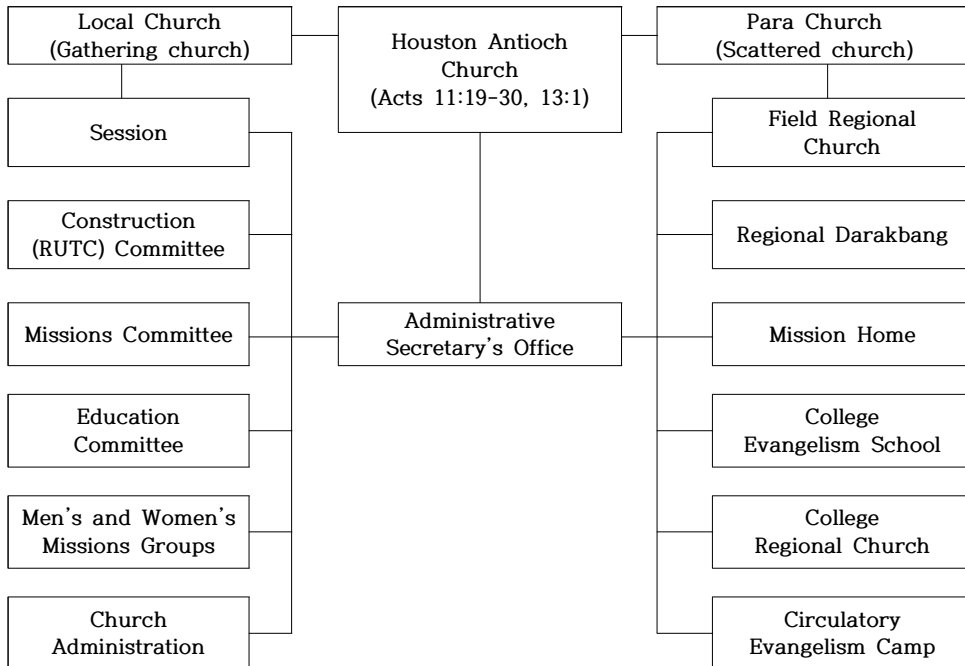
1. Houston Antioch Church's confession of faith
