How Can You Meet God?

John 14:6

[Introduction]

[Main]

1. God is Spirit.

- 1) Because God is Spirit, He is invisible with physical eyes. He is not limited by time or space.
- 2) Omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent – Jehovah (salvation is meeting God, who is Spirit)

2. But because mankind has physical body, we cannot see God.

- 1) Mankind's spirit is limited in physical body; the spirit leaving physical body is death.
- 2) Therefore, opportunity of salvation lies only when the spirit is in physical body.

3. The way to meet God

- 1) God, who is Spirit, came clothed in human body to save mankind (John 1:14).
- 2) Therefore, He is sinless; His spirit is God (1 Corinthians 15:45).
- 3) He is Jesus Christ.
- 4) Jesus has both divine and human nature (Matthew 16:16-19).

- 5) Receiving Jesus Christ is the way to meet God (John 1:12, Revelation 3:20).
- 6) As you receive Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit dwells in our spirit. This is salvation (John 14:16, 26-27).
- 7) At this moment, Satan's authority departs forever.
- 8) Let us give a prayer confessing and accepting that we truly believe in Jesus Christ.

* Follow the prayer below, sincerely!

Father God! I am a sinner. I lived and did what I wanted. But, now, I believe in the fact that Jesus is the Christ who has died on the cross for me and resurrected. I open the door of my heart and receive Jesus as my Lord and Savior. Come into my heart and lead me eternally. I pray in the name of the living Jesus Christ. Amen.

4. Evidence that God is with me

- 1) Indwelling and guidance of the Holy Spirit (John 14:26-27).
- 2) When you sincerely receive God's Word, you receive guidance of the Holy Spirit (Hebrews 4:12, Psalm 119:25).
- 3) When your sin is taken care of, you receive guidance of the Holy Spirit (Psalm 66:18, Galatians 5:16-18).
- 4) When you pray sincerely, at a time that has set apart, with specific topics, persistently, God's power is manifested.
- 5) Satan, which is the deceiving spirit and has lost hold of you, tries to hinder us through demons. That is why God commands you to be filled with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 5:18).
- 6) When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, you receive power (Acts 1:8).
- 7) Doors of evangelism are opened; evidence that God is alive is manifested.
