Moses' Covenant Journey

Exodus 3:18

[Introduction] Moses' 120 years of life

1. 40 years in a palace: skill summit (Moses who saw the world's reality, facts, truths, spiritual truth)
2. 40 years in the wilderness: spiritual summit (Moses who regained spiritual strength)
3. 40 years after the exodus: cultural summit (Moses who broke down old frames and prepared new frames)

[Main Body]

1. Covenant which Moses grabbed hold

- 1) Exodus 2:1-10, man of the covenant who was born in a Levite family (1 Peter 2:9)
- 2) Exodus 3:16-18, blood sacrifice and the covenant of the land of Canaan
- 3) Exodus 23:14-16, covenant of three feasts
- 4) Exodus 24:1-18, covenant of Mount Sinai (the Ten Commandments)
- 5) Exodus 26-27, covenant of tabernacle and the Ark of the Covenant
- 6) Deuteronomy 6:4-9, covenant regarding posterities

2. Covenant journey that Moses enjoyed

- 1) Exodus 1:8-22, Moses was born in the midst of crisis of death that Pharaoh commanded
- 2) Exodus 2:1-2, Moses was born in the Levite tribe and had background of the covenant and prayers
- 3) Exodus 2:5-10, Moses, as a son of a princess, received the covenant from his mother until he was weaned

- 4) Exodus 2:11-25, Moses ran to Midian
- 5) Exodus 3:1-22, calling at the Mount Horeb and God's covenant (verse 17-18)
- 6) Exodus 5:1-12:39, 10 plagues that came upon Moses and Egypt before the Pharaoh
- 7) Exodus 12:40, Israel's exodus and 40 years in the wilderness
- 8) Deuteronomy 34:1-12, Moses' death and disciples who were left behind (Joshua, Caleb)

3. Life masterpiece that Moses left behind

- 1) Eternal covenant: blood covenant, tabernacle, Ark of the Covenant (the Ten Commandments), three feasts
- 2) Deuteronomy 6:4-9, covenant regarding posterities (imprint, root, nature)
- 3) Deuteronomy 34:9, Moses left the greatest disciples (Joshua, Caleb)
- 4) Pentateuch (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy)
