Isaiah 6:13, 7:14

[Introduction]

Power of the Gospel and unstoppable Gospel movement

1. Samuel: Gospel movement restored in 14 generations
2. Moses- Gospel movement restored in 400 years
3. Isaiah: Gospel movement restored in 700 years
4. Martin Luther: Gospel movement restored in 500 years
5. Gospel movement in the last age

1. Covenant which Isaiah grabbed hold

- 1) Isaiah 6:13, stump
- 2) Isaiah 7:14, Immanuel

2. Covenant journey that Isaiah enjoyed

- 1) Isaiah came to realize reasons of Israel's destruction and salvation
 - (1) 1 Kings 20, mistake of King Hezekiah who boasted healing from sickness
 - (2) 2 Kings 22–25, kings of Judah who committed evil things before the LORD (Manasseh, Amon, Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin, Zedekiah) → Israel became captives of Babylon
- 2) Isaiah was called as a prophet and saw the glory of the throne (Isaiah 6:1-8)
- 3) Isaiah discovered and relayed God's heavenly mandate, calling, commission
 - (1) Isaiah 6:13, covenant of stump → restoration of remnants

- (2) Isaiah 7:14, covenant of Immanuel → restoration of the Gospel
- (3) Isaiah 40:1-31, what will remain forever and remains temporarily → restoration of the Word and power
- (4) Isaiah 41:8-16, 43:1-28, God's calling and being with him → restoration of the power of the Word
- (5) Isaiah 60:1-22, God's absolute plan
- (6) Isaiah 62:6-12, blessing of a watchman and world evangelization

3. Life masterpiece that Isaiah left behind

- 1) The Fifth Gospel: Isaiah 7:14
- 2) Covenant of stump (Isaiah 6:13, Remnant movement) and the most important covenant of world evangelization
